### Goal:

Improve community access to nutritious food by removing barriers related to cost, transportation, and availability, ensuring everyone can access healthy food.

EVCF evaluates all initiatives based on financial, operational, legal/liability, reputational, and mission alignment criteria to ensure low-risk and high-impact outcomes.

### Strategy 1 Nourishment for All



- Strengthen and enhance The Community Market programs and operations.
- Strengthen the local economy by supporting and promoting local farmers, ranchers, and food producers, fostering sustainable practices and building a resilient food system.
- Support community programs addressing the nutritional needs of all age groups through collaboration with donors, partners, and volunteers, while leveraging partnerships and exploring innovative solutions to food insecurity.
- Reduce the environmental impact of food waste in our community.

### **Milestones:**

- Launch a data-driven dashboard to guide program evaluation and operational improvement
- Increase in-kind food donations and rescue initiatives
- Increase number of customers served through the mobile markets and offer engagement/feedback opportunities
- Maintain food quality from local sources at market price (or below) and stay within budget
- Expand regional food sourcing and partnerships
- Promote local food producers and their products (including imperfect produce) through marketing campaigns
- Increase number of volunteers participating in food distribution efforts
- Increase access to nutrition education and include mental health, physical activity, and stress management components
- Support initiatives and partners that contribute to food security Increase food distribution to individuals first, animals second, and lastly, compost
- Launch a volunteer program focused on sustainability
- Achieve and maintain Actively Green cert
- Create a sustainability educational curriculum to increase awareness and community-wide engagement

# Strategy 2 Wellness and Access for All



- Connect individuals with essential resources and assist in navigating available services efficiently.
- Promote health and wellness services, resources, and education for the Spanish-speaking community in Eagle County.
- Enhance partnerships for comprehensive, year-round access to community services.

### **Milestones:**

- Create a centralized resource platform to address community needs
- Implement a case management system to provide personalized support and guidance to individuals navigating services
- Expand community reach through the purchase of a second van, bringing services and resources to additional locations
- Expand bilingual health and wellness services to promote participation of the Spanish-speaking community
- Produce and distribute culturally relevant health education and wellness materials in Spanish
- Increase number of partner organizations participating and Spanish-speaking community members attending the annual MIRA Health and Wellness
- Fair Strengthen existing partnerships through regular collaborative meetings
- Recruit new partners and collaborations that will ensure a comprehensive network of services available year-round

- Empower emerging leaders by fostering inclusive leadership development and creating equitable opportunities for economic and social advancement in Eagle County.

### **Milestones:**

- Increase number of meetings and forums that facilitate dialogue and collaboration among nonprofits, government agencies, and private sector leaders
- Initiate additional collaborative projects as a direct result of the gatherings
- Strengthen partner engagement through repeat participants

- Develop a fiscal sponsorship guide/handbook detailing applicant process, expectations, and reporting requirements
- Implement a Financial
  Management Training

  compliance
- Launch a financial tracking system to be utilized by sponsored organizations

- Expand ELEVAR leadership development programs through advanced training and mentorship opportunities
- Increase the funding allocated through ELEVAR to support local BIPOC-owned businesses and initiatives
- Strengthen regional partnerships to create a support network for emerging BIPOC leaders
